United Methodist Retirement Communities (UMRC) Foundation Receives \$20,000 from United Way for Southeastern Michigan

Gift Provides for Emergency Needs of Older Detroiters Served at The Thome Rivertown Neighborhood

Detroit, MI, June 23, 2020 – The UMRC Foundation is pleased to announce it has received a grant of \$20,000 from the United Way for Southeastern Michigan. These funds will support emergency needs such as food and personal hygiene essentials as well as iPads and technology for low-income older adults living at The Thome Rivertown Neighborhood Affordable Assisted Living in Detroit (Rivertown). A partnership between UMRC and other senior living organizations, Rivertown is an innovative model of affordable healthcare and housing options located in Detroit's East Jefferson corridor.

Ninety-five percent of Rivertown residents live well below the poverty level, with an average income of just \$700 per month. Although Rivertown provides outstanding, one-of-a-kind housing, services and programs for frail, low-income older adults, many basic needs may still go unmet. "Some of our residents come to Rivertown with basically nothing," said Julia Szuper, Executive Director of Rivertown Affordable Assisted Living. "Their needs are amplified now, due to the COVID-19 pandemic. We are grateful for this grant from the United Way for Southeastern Michigan and its partnership in caring for our Rivertown residents."

"COVID-19 has been especially catastrophic for older adults, persons of color, and those with limited means – the very population we serve at Rivertown," said Wendy Brightman, President of the UMRC Foundation and Porter Hills Foundation. "We are thrilled to receive this gift from the United Way for Southeastern Michigan that will mean so much to our assisted living residents and their families and help us enhance the health, well-being, and dignity of those we serve."
