A Staff Scholarship from the UMRC Foundation is helping Hannah fulfill her dream of completing the nursing program at Michigan State University. "The more education I get, the better I can assist our wonderful residents here at UMRC," says Hannah, currently in her second year of college. "Not very many workplaces offer scholarships. This helps remove a lot of financial stress for me."

Especially now during the COVID-19 pandemic, Hannah, who started her job in April, is experiencing the dedication and determination of healthcare workers. "When everyone else is afraid of the risk, we rise to the challenge, risking our own health and that of our loved ones to care for our residents who become like family."

This Jackson native says, "Working at UMRC has opened my eyes in unimaginable ways. A nurse's role in healthcare is much more than the average person may notice. It's not about the money or the job title, it is about creating the best quality of life for the person in need. In addition to physical care, they rely on us to feel safe and to feel love. Nurses and healthcare workers make a difference, and I love being a part of it."

ian Sutawijaya, or Dee, moved from Indonesia to Michigan four years ago with her husband, a Grand Rapids native. In her country, Dee had been a social studies teacher for eleven years.

Dee had never thought about becoming a caregiver, until she returned to Indonesia to care for her gravely ill grandmother. When Dee came back to Grand Rapids, she decided to use these skills to help others.

Nearly two years ago, Dee began working at Porter Hills Village in its "Catered" Assisted Living center, first as a resident assistant and, currently, as a medical technician. This fall, Dee was delighted to learn that the Porter Hills Foundation was launching its **Staff Scholarship** program. "I had been saving to begin an LPN program," says Dee. "This scholarship is allowing my goal to happen faster." Eventually, she hopes to earn her BSN degree.

"Kindness, compassion, and empathy" is Dee's philosophy for nursing. "I like interacting with older adults and encouraging them to be as independent as they can be, to show compassion and touch their hearts."

She understands how difficult the social isolation has been for residents who are separated from loved ones as a result of COVID-19. "When I know there is something they like, I do whatever I can to make sure they get it," says Dee, whether it's stopping by their room to visit, offering a manicure, or making a special sugar-free treat for a resident with diabetes. "Their happiness is my goal."

For example, Dee brought a chocolate cake for Helen's 99th birthday, just days before Helen passed away. Helen's son, Dale Hotelling says, "It was clear that a most special bond formed between Dee and our mother during Mom's 18 months at Porter Hills. Our family's lives have been enriched by Dee's presence among us."

Shore to Shore: Saluting Our Life Enrichment Teams

The City Church of Sparta paid Meadowlark Retirement Village residents a visit, helping get everyone in the holiday spirit from the safety of their homes.



020 brought a host of COVID-19-related challenges, not the least of which was how to fill the void created by the restriction on visits of family and friends for our residents. Our Life Enrichment teams from shore to shore have gone above and beyond, showing their determination, creativity, and love for the older adults they serve.

"When the pandemic began, our Life Enrichment teams were faced with thinking of new ways to keep residents engaged," says Maegan Garlock, Residential Living Community Engagement Manager at Porter Hills Village. "Our goal is to work with elders to maintain independence, stay connected to community, and have an overall high quality of life. This pandemic has brought an opportunity for our teams to demonstrate just how deeply devoted we are."

Several grants helped provide iPads for older adults to stay connected with family and friends. "We challenged our creativity, adapted our approaches, and learned how to use almost every type of communication platform out there, to keep residents connected to their families," says Josie Pezzullo, Life Enrichment Coordinator at UMRC's Kresge Healthcare and Rehabilitation Center.

Creative engagement activities have included: group exercise with residents from the hallway, weekly hospitality carts, pen pals with community members, outdoor concerts, and window visits, to name just a few.

Our Life Enrichment teams across the state have also looked to each other for support.

"Our engagement teams have worked together to share resources and ideas and have maintained a positive outlook," says Maegan. "In conversations with peers in other organizations, I can see the difference in the level of support we have as an organization. None of this would be possible without the support of the entire UMRC & Porter Hills family. We have been blessed with the resources to carry us through this experience."

"We have learned through this process, that the biggest impact comes from the most simple interactions – a smile, a conversation, bringing residents their favorite snack. Engagement and morale are a team effort, and the entire Kresge Center team is doing its best to provide the little things because those are the things that have made the biggest impact," says Josie.

"Working through the Covid-19 pandemic with assisted living residents has brought a rollercoaster of emotions," says Kori Rochefort, Assisted Living Life Enrichment Coordinator at Chelsea Retirement Community. "I have been sad, scared, stressed, mad, grateful, and happy that I can help. It has made me value the little things much more. Each day I park in the same parking space. When I arrive and leave work, I wave at one of our residents and he waves back. One day with tears in his eyes, he said, 'You just don't know how much you waving at me each day means.' We have focused on keeping residents' spirits up with a wave, a listening ear, a cup of coffee, a smile, or even a song and dance."

Hazel Mead, Independent Living Life Enrichment Coordinator at Chelsea Retirement Community, agrees. "We are their family."


Staying active as we age is key to maintaining physical and mental health and well-being.



Leading the Way

MRC & Porter Hills' PACE programs in Ypsilanti, Jackson, Lansing, Muskegon, and Holland are leading the way! Here are a few of this year's highlights:

Huron Valley PACE hits a milestone of over 200 participants. During the pandemic, Huron Valley PACE has offered overnight respite stays for its participants to provide a needed break for families.

Thome PACE – Grants totaling \$1,250,000 from the Edward N. and Della L. Thome Memorial Foundation and The Harry and Jeanette Weinberg Foundation, Inc. helped to expand the Thome PACE Day Health Center in Jackson.

LifeCircles PACE – A \$100,000 grant from the Michigan Health Endowment Fund is bringing the **Positive Approach**TM to Care dementia training to LifeCircles team members, families, and community members over the next two years, to provide improved care and minimize stress for persons living with dementia and their care partners.

Senior CommUnity Care of Michigan PACE welcomed new Executive Director, Ken Robbins, who took the helm just as COVID-19 hit. Three regional care teams were created to effectively and efficiently manage participant care using the home-based model.

All of our PACE sites have ramped up both their in-home care and services as well as their telehealth capabilities this year during the pandemic, thanks to grants from the Michigan Health Endowment Fund, United Way of Washtenaw County, and the Community Foundation of Holland/Zeeland.



She and her late husband, Jack, were members at Westminster Presbyterian Church when Mrs. Paul F. (Marion Pampel) Steketee, Sr. organized a group to develop senior living in Grand Rapids. This group was comprised of businessmen, financial analysts, and attorneys, like Jack. "We were part of the process from the first spade-ful to the dedication of Porter Hills," says Jan. "Our



children were young then. After construction began on Porter Hills, Jack and I would check on the progress nearly every evening and our kids would play in the sand in the construction area."

Jack went on to serve on the Porter Hills Board for 31 years, dedicating his life as a volunteer at Porter Hills. Jan also volunteered as a member and president of the Porter Hills Women's Board. "We did everything!" she says, including decorating the halls at Christmas, throwing monthly birthday parties for residents, organizing craft shows, and raising funds for Porter Hills. Their son also served on the Porter Hills Board prior to the affiliation with UMRC.

Jack's mother was among the first residents at Porter Hills. In 2000, Jack and Jan were some of the first to move into Cook Valley Estates. Today, she enjoys living in the Garden Apartments at Porter Hills Village.

Jan says she appreciates the mission of Porter Hills, especially the importance of Benevolent Care. The Porter Hills Foundation is included in the Bowies' estate plan as Porter Hills Legacy Society members. "Porter Hills has been our lives' work."
