He has served as President and Chief Executive Office for Brio Living Services (formerly UMRC and Porter Hills) since May 2019. Prior to serving as President and CEO, Steve served as UMRC Vice President and CFO from 2014 to 2018, and as Interim CEO from November 2018 until May 2019.

In his role as CEO, he is responsible for all aspects of operations and strategy for Brio Living Services.
