Porter Hills Home Health Care Announces Additional Nurses to Its Team

Offers Enhanced Care to Michigan Lakeshore Area

Grand Rapids, MI, Nov. 17, 2025 – Porter Hills Home Health Care, a program of senior living organization, Brio Living Services, has announced the addition of two nurses to round out its team. This additional staffing will enable Porter Hills Home Health Care to better provide skilled nursing care for clients living in the Michigan Lakeshore area.

"With a fully staffed nursing department, Porter Hills Home Health Care is now able to provide high quality nursing care in the geographical areas where we were limited to only providing therapies," said Amy Thackery, Executive Director of Porter Hills Home Health Care. "I am delighted that our new team members will help us improve and enhance the care options we are able to provide to clients throughout our 50-mile radius of service, many of whom live in more rural areas of the counties we serve."

Hospitals and health care providers in Porter Hills Home Health Care's service area refer adults who have recently been released from the hospital or rehabilitation, or residents in the community for whom their provider has determined they are at risk for hospitalization because of a new or previously poorly managed health issue.

Porter Hills Home Health Care offers skilled nursing, such as wound care, post-surgical care, and medical management; rehabilitation therapy, including licensed physical, occupational, and speech-language therapists; as well as remote patient monitoring and technology to help clients recover from an illness or injury, or assist with an ongoing physical health challenge. This includes 24/7 access to clinical professionals for emergency issues and referrals. The Porter Hills Home Health Care team is comprised of skilled nurses, medical social workers, and therapists, who bring care directly to the clients so they can recover in the comfort of their own home.

"Because we provide care in the client's home, we really get to know that person and can tailor our services to fit their unique needs and lifestyle," said Thackery. "Although our service area does include a 50-mile radius from the heart of Grand Rapids, we were not always able to offer the optimal nursing care choices for people living along the Lakeshore area of Michigan, from Muskegon to Holland and further south, and sometimes had to turn people away who lived in

this area. With two additional nurses joining our excellent team, we want our partners to know we are fully staffed to bring our highly regarded care and service to as many as 200 clients per month."

Known throughout the region for its quality home health care, therapies, and services, Porter Hills Home Health Care is reviewed by Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) and is consistently rated as four-star out of a possible five stars.
